<i>First line support</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Resolve any immediately solvable problem. • Escalate any other problem to the relevant person within the ICT department. • Report any suspected “bugs” to NetSuite support. • Report any enhancement requests to NetSuite and keep staff updated as to the progress of their request. • Support and maintain equipment (desktops, laptops, printers and other peripherals)
<i>NetSuite Maintenance</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Run daily, weekly and monthly maintenance. • Maintain “public” saved searches and views. • Create and modify NetSuite searches and reports. • Maintain NetSuite forms to make sure they meet the business needs. • Create and modify NetSuite email templates • Maintain roles and dashboards for staff
<i>Documentation</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Document the internal design of any development in order to ease maintenance in the future. • Create and maintain user instructions and maintenance guides where appropriate.
<i>NetSuite Development and Support</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Work with the Systems Analysts to develop bespoke solutions suited to the business needs. • Willingness to learn JavaScript, HTML, FreeMarker and basic SQL to support the Systems Analysts in the development of NetSuite. • Maintain own tasks within the company project management tools.

OTHER DUTIES:

1. To participate in the company's PDR process
2. To undertake relevant staff development/training
3. To be responsible for the health and safety of self and others
